Pursuant to 85A O.S. § 50(H)(14), the Workers’ Compensation Commission has contracted with Fair Health to review regional and nationwide comparisons of Oklahoma’s Fee Schedule rates and data and markets for medical services. The Commission also contracted with Fair Health to provide a report of its findings and a proposed amended Fee Schedule to the Commission upon receipt of oral and written comments. The Commission and Fair Health will hear public comments on potential revisions of Oklahoma’s current Fee Schedule.
