PRODUCT AND SERVICE CONTRACTS

EXECUTIVE SUMMARY

The State of Oklahoma realized savings in excess of \$24 million for fiscal year 2016 through managed contracts of products and services other than information technology. Twenty-five of 104 statewide contracts are currently being tracked for cost savings. Savings for the 25 statewide contracts are summarized below:

Notes regarding cost savings calculations

Simplified cost savings and cost avoidance formulas were used to calculate savings percentage.

- (Historical Price New Price) / (Historical Price)
- (Average of Responsive Bids Awarded Bid) / (Average of Responsive Bids)

Savings calculations are conservative and represent only savings which can be easily quantified.

Several issues led Central Purchasing to take a very conservative approach to calculating savings. Those issues include:

- Incomplete usage data as reported by suppliers for each contract.
- Multiple discount percentages across a specific contract in which Central Purchasing would have taken the discount with the least percentage off of list prices.
