



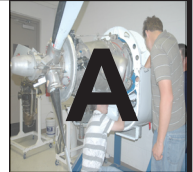
AIRPORTS

- Leveraged federal dollars with state funds as never before, resulting in the most productive decade in state history insofar as the construction of airport infrastructure.
- 42 of Oklahoma's 49 regional business airports are jet capable. About 93 percent of Oklahoma's population is within 25 miles of a jet-capable airport.
- Received FAA award for its outstanding contributions to the enhancement of aviation in Oklahoma.
- The Oklahoma Airport System Plan is used by the FAA as a model for other states.
- 97 percent of Oklahoma's population is within 25 miles of one of the state's 49 regional business airports. The majority of the state's largest employers use our airports to conduct their business more efficiently.
- 68 percent of annual revenues expended on airport infrastructure.
- Awarded state grants for the construction of new airport terminals in Shawnee and Durant, the first time ever state grants were provided for terminals.



PROMOTION OF AVIATION & AEROSPACE

- Led the passage HB 3239, the Aerospace Industry Engineer Workforce Bill, which has significantly helped address the shortage of engineers in the state's aerospace industry.
- Led the passage of HB 1577 that eliminated the sales tax on all aircraft maintenance, repair and overhaul work, the backbone of the state's world-renown aerospace industry.
- Led the passage of the Aerospace Development Act, creating the Center for Aerospace Supplier Quality (CASQ) and the Oklahoma Aerospace Institute (OAI).
- Led the passage of HB 2501, providing a balance to the Aircraft Dealers Protection Act and causing manufacturers like Cessna to re-enter Oklahoma.
- Through FY10, CASQ has helped 22 OK aerospace companies win 217 defense contracts worth \$14.7 million.
- OAI has successfully developed state's first-ever research agenda and strategic plan in 2009 for OK's aerospace industry, and is establishing an aerospace workforce resource center.
- Created the Aerospace Industry Advisory Council, providing a forum for industry leaders to interact with state and federal government.
- Instrumental in creation of the Oklahoma Aerospace Alliance, the OK's first aerospace industry trade association.
- Instrumental in the formation of the Governor's Aerospace Task Force in 2003.
- Established Aviation Day at the state Capitol which showcases the importance of Oklahoma's aviation and aerospace industry to lawmakers and other elected officials.
- Partnered with other state agencies and entities to promote Oklahoma's aerospace industry at the National Business Aviation Association Annual Conference.
- Served as major sponsor for the Oklahoma Aerospace Summit, Oklahoma Airport Operators Association Annual Conference and the Wiley Post Spirit Award Banquet.



AVIATION EDUCATION

- Since 2000, awarded more than \$1 million in aviation education grants and contracts to programs and organizations across the state to encourage more young people to consider careers in aviation and expose more students to science, technology, engineering and math.
- Since 2003, organized and sponsored the Oklahoma International Aviation Art Contest.
- Helped establish the first Aerospace Education and Training Day during the 2008 Oklahoma Aerospace Summit & Expo.
