President McAllister swears in new members:

President Janis McAllister administered the Oath of Office to new Board Members, Gordon Richards of Shawnee and Dr. Diana Hampton of Edmond. Ms. McAllister and the Board members welcomed Mr. Richards and Dr. Hampton to the Board.

Approval of Minutes and claims:

Motion was made by Jim Spoon and seconded by Jerry Allen to approve the minutes of the May 22, 2003 Board meeting as corrected. Motion passed on roll call vote.

Motion was made by Jerry Allen and seconded by Jim Spoon to approve expense claims #456-#501 and #3020. Motion passed on roll call vote.

Motion was made by Jim Spoon and seconded by Gordon Richards to approve the expenses of the Executive Director. Motion passed on roll call vote.

Duplicate certificate request approved:

Motion was made by Jerry Allen and seconded by Diana Hampton to approve the duplicate DPh certificate requests from Carla Jo Bynum, D.Ph. #12096, Cheryl Derrico Hale, D.Ph. #12015 and Nicole A. Steiner, D.Ph. #11544. Motion passed on roll call vote.

Board withdraws Emergency Rules:

Motion was made by Jim Spoon and seconded by Jerry Allen to withdraw emergency rule 535:1-14-5. Motion passed on roll call vote. Vote was as follows: Jerry Allen-Aye, Diana Hampton-Aye, Gordon Richards-Aye and Jim Spoon-Aye.

Board discusses NAPLEX application for Monica Thomas:

Motion was made by Jerry Allen and seconded by Jim Spoon to decline the NAPLEX application of Monica Thomas. Ms. Thomas had failed the NAPLEX 3 times in another state. Motion passed on roll call vote.

Discussion on various items:

Mr. Potter presented the Board with information about the following items:

An email from Gary Glover of the Oklahoma Health Department was presented to the Board stating that John Foust will present an overview of the new Drug Room rules for regional meetings by the Health Department.

The Board reviewed a letter from Randy Farmer of PMC Quality Commitment, Inc. The letter suggest that their be a requirement for pharmacies to implement a program when excessive errors occur.

Emergency technician rules concerning the nomenclature were also discussed. It has been decided that there needs to be a new definition of Support Personnel, which would include Technicians, in order to comply with the statutes. This will be circulated to the Board and finalized at the August 9th meeting.

Board discusses suggested information from the staff on Internet inquiries:

Office Manager, Mary Ann Terral requested that the Board review different websites and determine what information should be accessible on the Board's new Internet inquiry program. The staff will try to present the possible program to the Board during the August meeting.

Cancellations of Pharmacist, Pharmacies and Facilities:

Motion was made by Jim Spoon and seconded by Gordon Richards to allow the staff to cancel those licenses and permits that have not been renewed. Motion passed on roll call vote.

Kevin Rich of OPHP request to appear before the Board:

Kevin Rich appeared before the Board to invite each one to attend the Southwest PRN meeting in Oklahoma City on October 3-5.

The building fire alarm system sounded and everyone had to evacuate the building.

Board meets with Reciprocity, Score Transfer and NAPLEX applicants:

The Board was called back to order around 9:00 a.m. with the interviews of 6 Reciprocity applicants, 1 Score Transfer applicant and 4 NAPLEX applicants. All were accepted upon passing the Law exam and NAPLEX if applicable.

OSBP vs. Kelly Williams, D.Ph. #10657, Case No. 679:

The Board was called to order to hear the case of Kelly Williams. Ms. Williams was present without counsel. Grant Moak, Assistant Attorney General, prosecuted for the Board.

Ms. Williams had received two administrative warnings within a 12-month period. After hearing testimony and reviewing the evidence that was presented, a motion was made by Jerry Allen and seconded by Gordon Richards that Ms. Williams be found guilty. Motion passed on roll call vote.

Motion was made by Jim Spoon and seconded by Diana Hampton that Ms. Williams review the video on errors and have a letter of reprimand placed in her file for a period of 90 days. Motion passed on roll call vote.

OSBP vs. Angie Stanley, D.Ph. #12842, Case No. 677:

President McAllister called the Board to order to hear the case of Angela Stanley. Ms. Stanley chose to appear without counsel. Assistant Attorney General, Grant Moak, prosecuted the case for the Board.

The Board was presented with an Agreed Order. If the Board accepts the Agreed Order, the respondent's license would be suspended for 10 years and the suspension would be stayed. The respondent would be required to enter into and abide by an OPHP contract and after 5 years, may request that the suspension be lifted.

Motion was made by Jim Spoon and seconded by Jerry Allen to accept the Agreed Order. Motion passed on roll call vote.

OSBP vs. Michael Jordan, D.Ph. #10013, Case No. 598-requesting probation:

President McAllister called the Board to order to hear a request for probation by Michael Jordan.

Motion was made by Jim Spoon and seconded by Gordon Richards to place Mr. Jordan's license on probation and allow him to reinstate his license. Mr. Jordan agreed to continue with the Board requirements in the original order. He would agree to working with another pharmacist for the first 6 months. He also agreed to not become an owner of a pharmacy. Motion passed on roll call vote.

OSBP vs. Barry E. Craig, D.Ph. #11238, Case No. 590-requesting probation:

Barry Craig appeared before the Board requesting probation on Case No. 590. Motion was made by Jim Spoon and seconded by Gordon Richards to place Mr. Craig's license on probation providing he correct the dilute drug screens and continue the Board requirements in the original order. He is to notify each employer of his Board action and agree not to work relief type situations where he had to travel and go to different stores on a regular basis. Motion passed on roll call vote.

Complaint Consideration:

Compliance Officer, Gary LaRue, presented 6 possible cases to the Board to consider hearing. Motion was made by Jerry Allen and seconded by Jim Spoon to hear the complaints. Motion passed on roll call vote.

Board discusses letter from Charles Duhon, D.Ph.:

Mr. Potter presented a letter from Charles Duhon, D.Ph. from Tulsa. Mr. Duhon has suggested that the Board study the possibility of rules or guidelines regarding the requirements of support personnel when a pharmacy is doing a certain volume of prescriptions.

Motion was made by Jerry Allen and seconded by Diana Hampton to have the new President work with staff to implement a study on this issue. Motion passed on roll call vote.

Board sets next Board meeting:

The next Board meeting was set for August 14, 2003.

Re-Organization of the Board:

President McAllister called the Board to order for reorganization. Motion was made by Gordon Richards and seconded by Diana Hampton to elect Jerry Allen as President and James Spoon as Vice-President for the year 2003-2004. Motion passed on roll call vote.

Jerry Allen stated for the record that Janis McAllister had been a very good President and had represented the Board well this past year.
