Approval of Minutes and Claims:

Motion was made by Jim Spoon and seconded by John Lassiter to approve the minutes of the August 16, 2006 Board meeting. Motion passed on roll call vote.

Motion was made by Jim Spoon and seconded by John Lassiter to approve expense claims #1233-#1271, #H21427-#H21430, August and September payroll claims and the accrued expenses of the Executive Director. Motion passed on roll call vote.

Board visits with Dale Black of OBN:

Dale Black of OBN discussed the PSE and the CDS tracking programs with the Board members. It appears that the programs are working well.

Board discusses evaluation of Executive Director:

The Board will be asked to do an evaluation of the Executive Director, which will be conducted by President Richards.

Board discusses the Appeal in District Court:

Assistant Attorney General, Brinda White, reviewed the process of the appeal by Gary Nichols in District Court, which has been delayed for 30 days.

Board discusses upcoming meetings:

A discussion was held on upcoming meetings. Members that are attending NCPA will be Bill Osborn and Jim Spoon. Mr. Potter will attend the NABP District VI meeting in Little Rock. Dorothy Gourley, John Lassiter and Bryan Potter will be attending the NABP Fall meeting in Savannah.

OSBP vs. Michael S. Russell, D.Ph. #8257 – Case No. 793:

The Board was called to order by Chairman Osborn to hear the case of Michael Russell. Mr. Russell was present with Counsel Julie Strong. Assistant Attorney General, Brinda White, was the prosecutor for the Board. Testifying for the Board were Compliance Officer, Cindy Hamilton, Kim McKown of Compass Vision and representatives from OPHP. Mr. Russell also testified as did Robert Nesbitt, M.D. of OU Health Science Center.

The Board heard testimony from the witnesses and then went into Executive Session. Upon returning from Executive Session, a motion was made by John Lassiter and seconded by Dorothy Gourley that based on the clear and convincing evidence that was presented, Mr. Russell be found guilty on the 6 counts in the Complaint. Motion passed on roll call vote.

Motion was made by Jim Spoon and seconded by Dorothy Gourley that Mr. Russell's pharmacist license be suspended for a period of 10 years and that he enter into and abide by a contract with OPHP. He may request probation by the Board upon OPHP's recommendation

that he is fit to return to work. Motion passed on roll call vote.

OSBP vs. DiGi Biddle, D.Ph. #11846 – Case No. 683 – Request for probation to be lifted:

The Board was called to order by Chairman Osborn to hear the request of DiGi Biddle. Ms. Biddle was requesting that the probation of her pharmacist license be lifted. Ms. Biddle was present without an attorney. Assistant Attorney General, Brinda White, represented the Board. Compliance Officer, Betty Beil reviewed the past case and the Final Order with the Board. The Board then interviewed Ms. Biddle.

Motion was made by John Lassiter and seconded by Dorothy Gourley to remove the probation as requested. Motion passed on roll call vote.

Board has working lunch:

The Board continued to meet with a working lunch while discussing possible Legislation and Rules that need to be worked on during the 2007 Session of the Legislature.
