This course should be completed prior to attempting to certify as canine team with the State of Oklahoma. The course is meant for beginner (green) handlers and beginner (green) canines. 2.6 If a handler has certified with previous narcotic canines, a one-week course shall suffice. The guidelines in 2.5 will not affect continuing education course, seminars, or 2.7 conferences.
