- Voter's name
- Voter's ID number
- Political affiliation
- Status
- Registration address
- Date of birth
- Date of registration
- Mailing address  
(if different from registration address)
- Election dates and method of voting

**Precinct/district information (Precinct Master.dat)  
includes:**

- Precinct number
- Congressional district
- State Senate district
- State House district
- County Commissioner district
- Name of polling place

Voter registration information available on CD from the State Election Board must be imported into user software to sort the information by ZIP Code, name, household or other ways as desired. **Lists or labels cannot be produced directly from these CDs.**

Information on each voter may include a registration address and/or a mailing address or even no address. Some addresses may not be satisfactory for mailing purposes; some information may be incomplete or missing. Telephone numbers are NOT included.

All data is written in ASCII format and is semicolon (;) delimited.

Requests for voter registration data will be filled within a reasonable time of request, usually 7-10 days. However, orders may be delayed on occasion due to election-related activities.

Fees will be charged according to the schedule on the following page. **Certified or cashier's checks** will be accepted and should be made payable to: OKLAHOMA STATE ELECTION BOARD. Payment by money order, company check or personal check will result in a substantial delay in receipt of data. Cash and credit cards are not accepted.

NOTE: Computer printouts of local voter registration/voter history information are available as public records for duplication under provisions of the Open Records Act at all County Election Board offices.

Statewide orders consist of 77 files by county. Caution! Large county or Congressional District files may be larger than 100MB each.
