

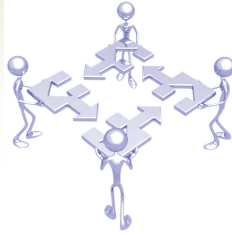

About Us...

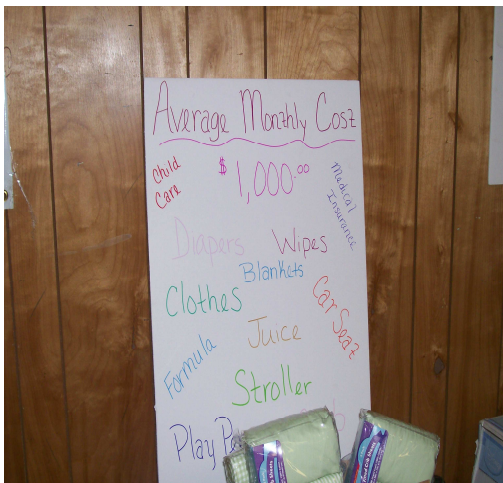
