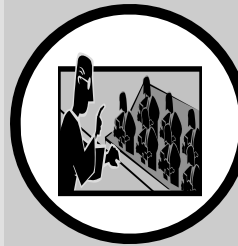

## ABOUT THE TRAINING:

This three day training will provide information for multidisciplinary team (MDT) core members who wish to learn more about the workings of the defense in child sexual abuse cases. Effective courtroom testimony training for each discipline will be covered as well as courtroom psychology. Additionally, forensic child sexual abuse medical examinations, investigations for law enforcement and child protective services. A mock trial will also be conducted.
