

LICENSED BEHAVIORAL PRACTITIONERS (LBP) EXAMINATION INFORMATION

ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS

An LBP applicant is eligible to take the licensing examination following the submission and approval of:

- Application form and fee
- Practicum/Internship Documentation Form
- Official transcript(s) showing completion of all academic requirements listed in Subchapter 13, section
- Three (3) Document of Recommendation forms
- Two (2) classifiable sets of fingerprints; and
- Examination fee

INSTRUCTIONS TO PURCHASE LOG-IN AND PASSWORD

1. Go to www.students.pearsoned.com and click "register"
2. Click "purchase online access"
3. Enter course ID – tracy24014 (lower case, no spaces) and click "next"
4. Verify course title – National Certified Psychologist – then click on "Course Compass Personal Edition - \$14.40" {subject to change}
5. Next page – click "No – I am a new user" then click "next"
6. Follow instructions to purchase log-in and password

4. Inside the box, click "**National Certified Psychologist**".
