## \*Front Porch Project

Option 1: Overview of the Front Porch Training – learn more about “Front Porch” in general.

Option 2: Complete Front Porch Community Training - provides community leaders with new tools and methods to more safely, confidently, appropriately, and frequently intervene when encountering a situation in which the treatment of a child makes them uncomfortable. Participants receive ideas and methods for intervention, as well as an opportunity (and expectation) to plan for how to take action in their own neighborhoods and communities.

Time Commitment (Option 1): Approximately 20 – 40 minutes

Time Commitment (Option 2): 2 full days of training (scheduled approximately four weeks apart)

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## \*Bridges Out of Poverty

*Training in the Bridges Out of Poverty will equip your staff or service providers with the best understanding of how to assist low-income people to facilitate responsible self-directed decision making, planning and ultimately self-sufficiency.*

*Reviews the Oklahoma Reporting law. Gives physical and emotional reactions to all types of abuse and neglect.*

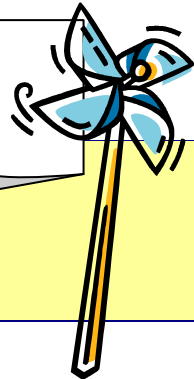

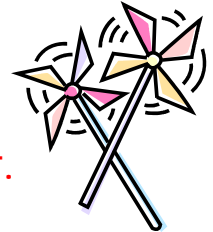

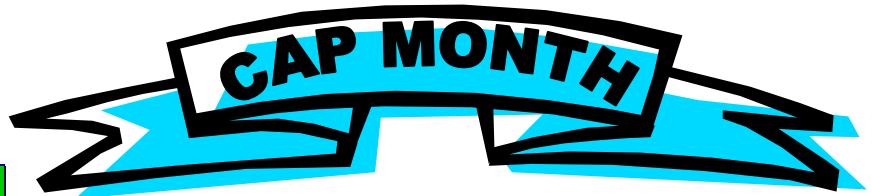
