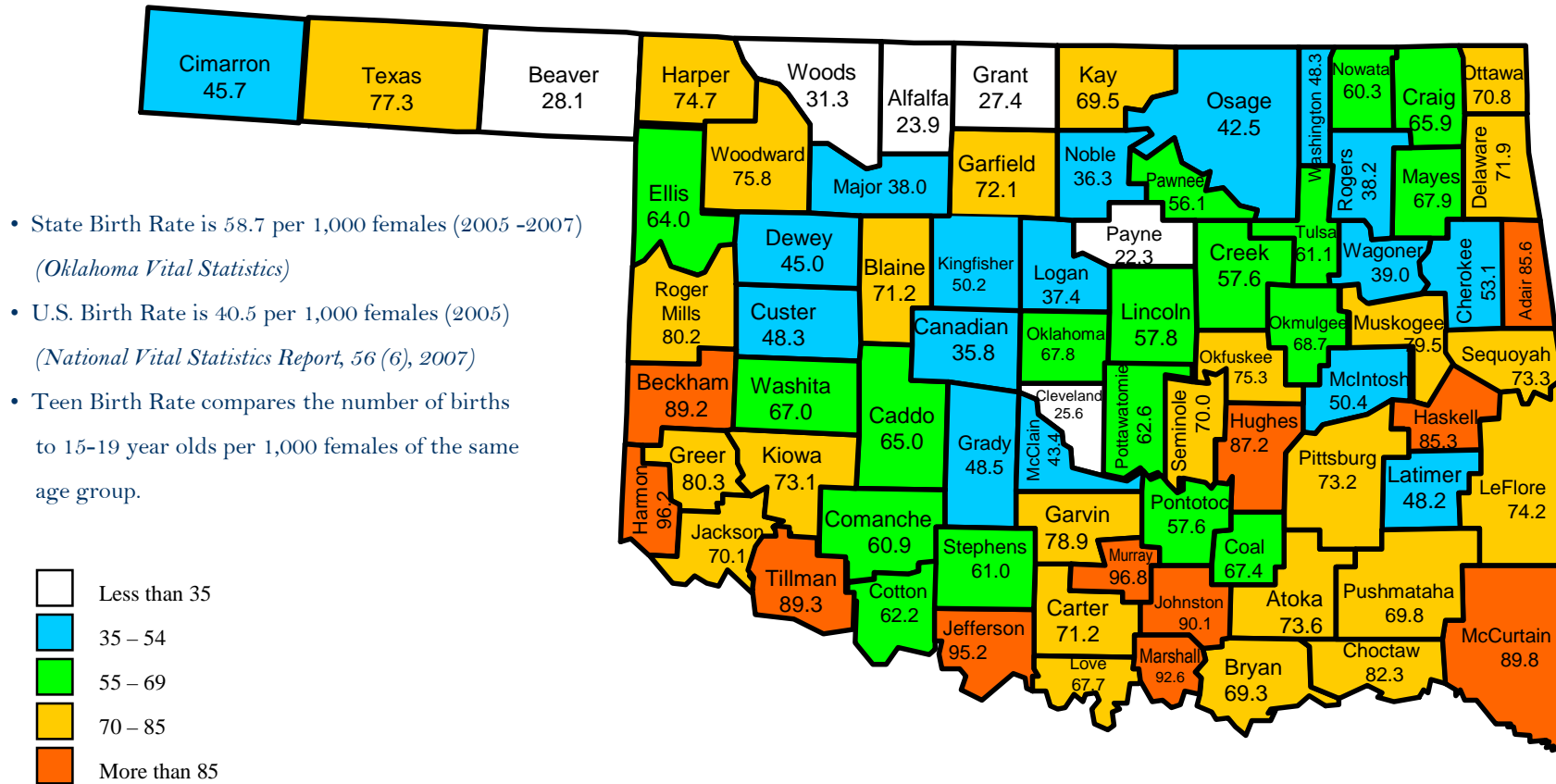


Oklahoma Teen Birth Rates By County

Birth rates of females ages 15-19 per 1,000 population. (2005 - 2007 average)



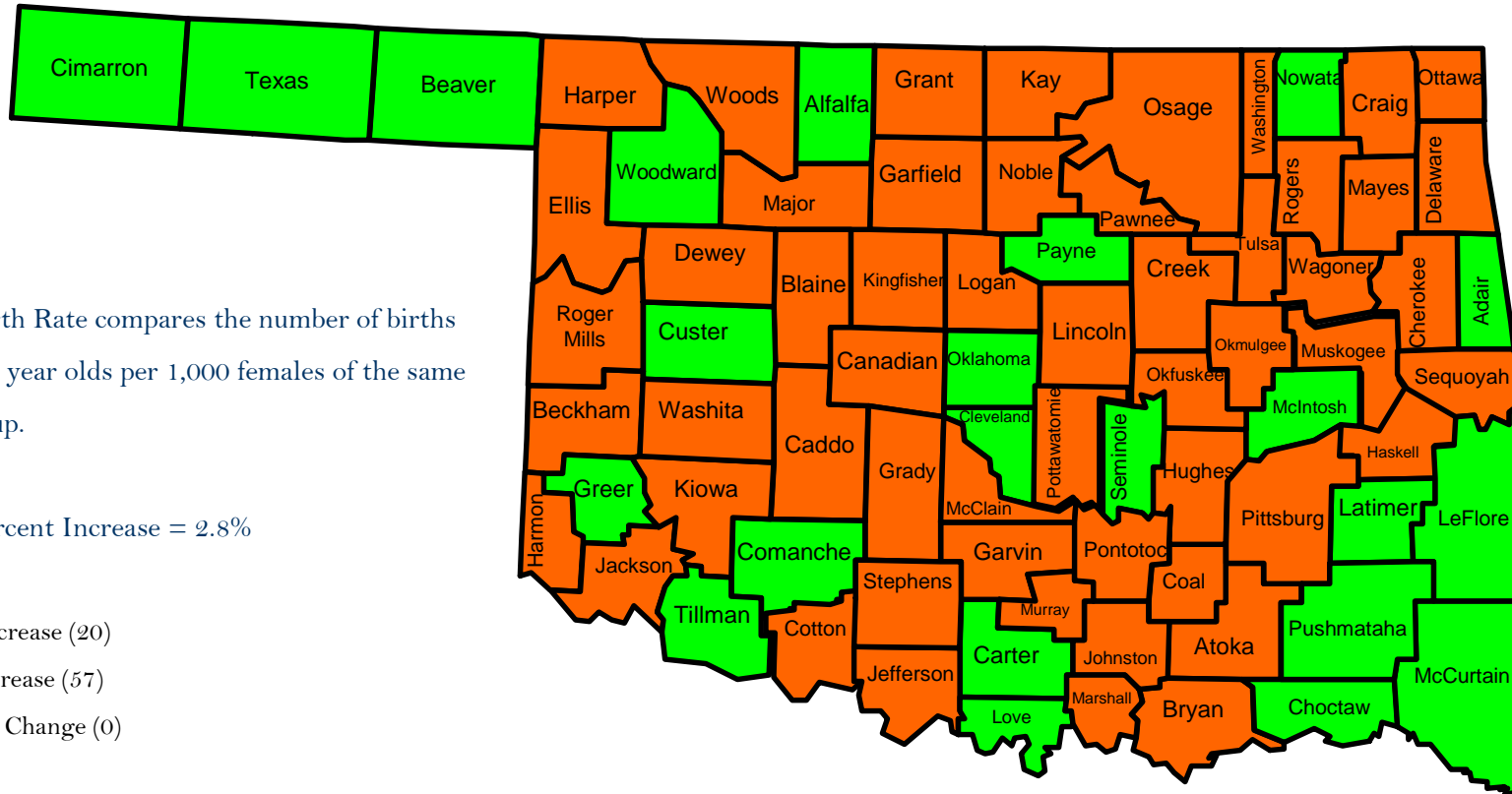
- State Birth Rate is 58.7 per 1,000 females (2005 -2007)
(Oklahoma Vital Statistics)
- U.S. Birth Rate is 40.5 per 1,000 females (2005)
(National Vital Statistics Report, 56 (6), 2007)
- Teen Birth Rate compares the number of births to 15-19 year olds per 1,000 females of the same age group.

65 of Oklahoma's 77 counties have teen birth rates higher than the national average of 40.5 per 1,000 girls (ages 15-19).

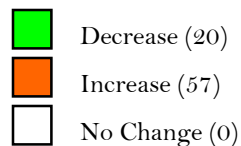

Percent change in the birth rate of females ages 15-19 per 1,000 population:
2005-2007 average compared to 2004 - 2006 average*.



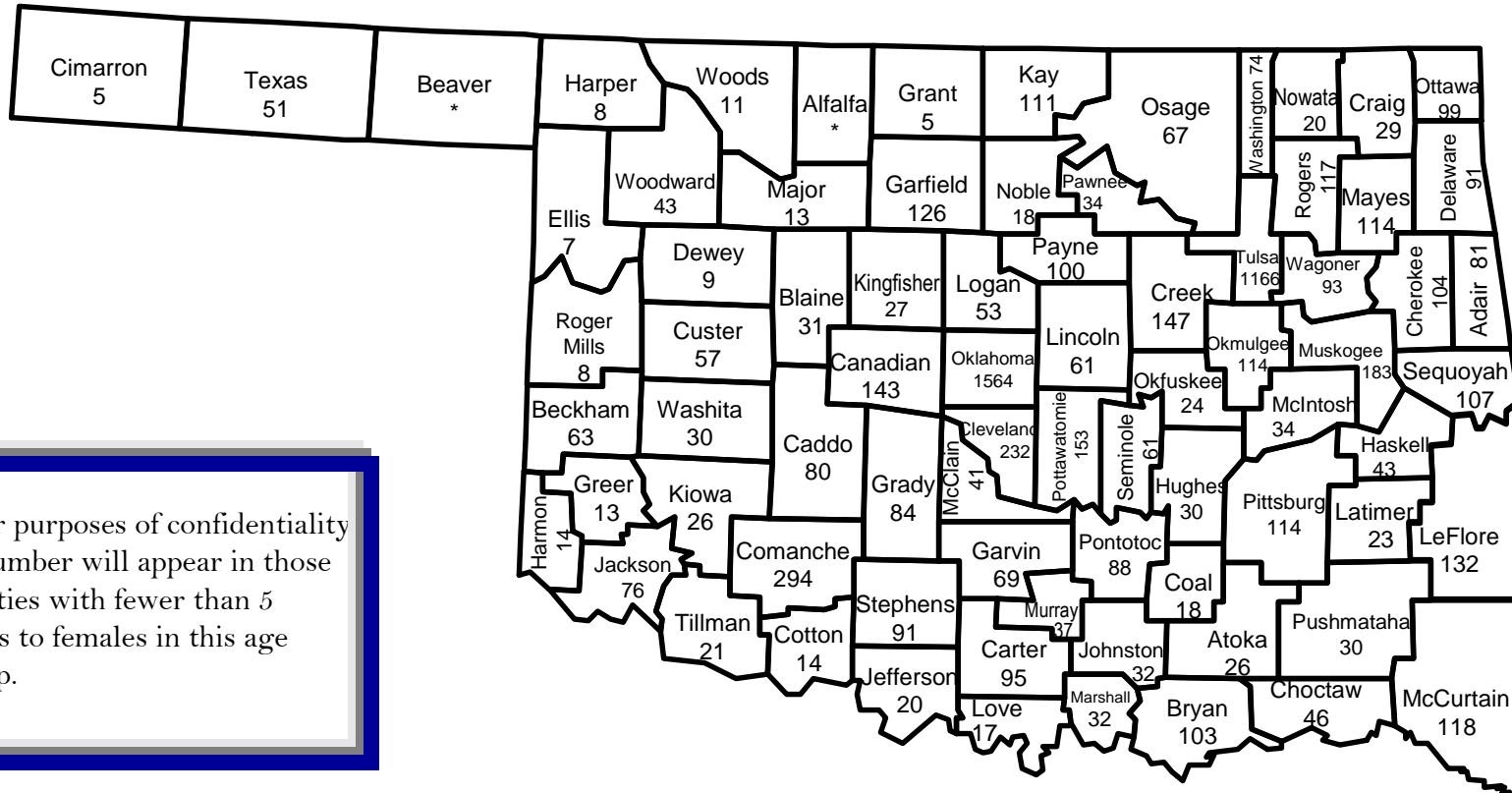
- Teen Birth Rate compares the number of births to 15-19 year olds per 1,000 females of the same age group.
- State Percent Increase = 2.8%

Oklahoma Teens Actual Births By County

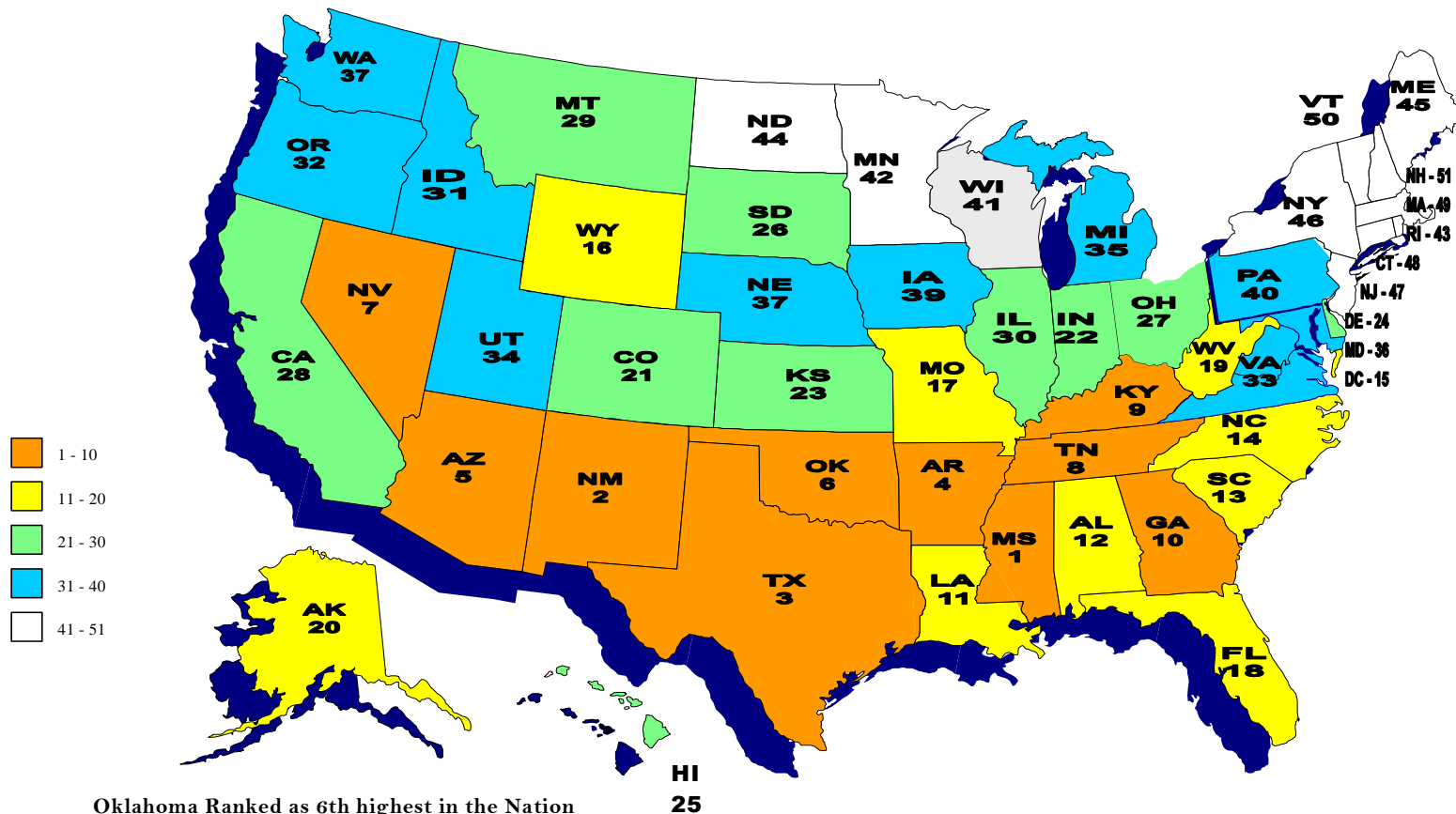
Number of actual live births to females ages 15-19 in 2007.

Birth rate based on number of births per 1,000 females of that population.



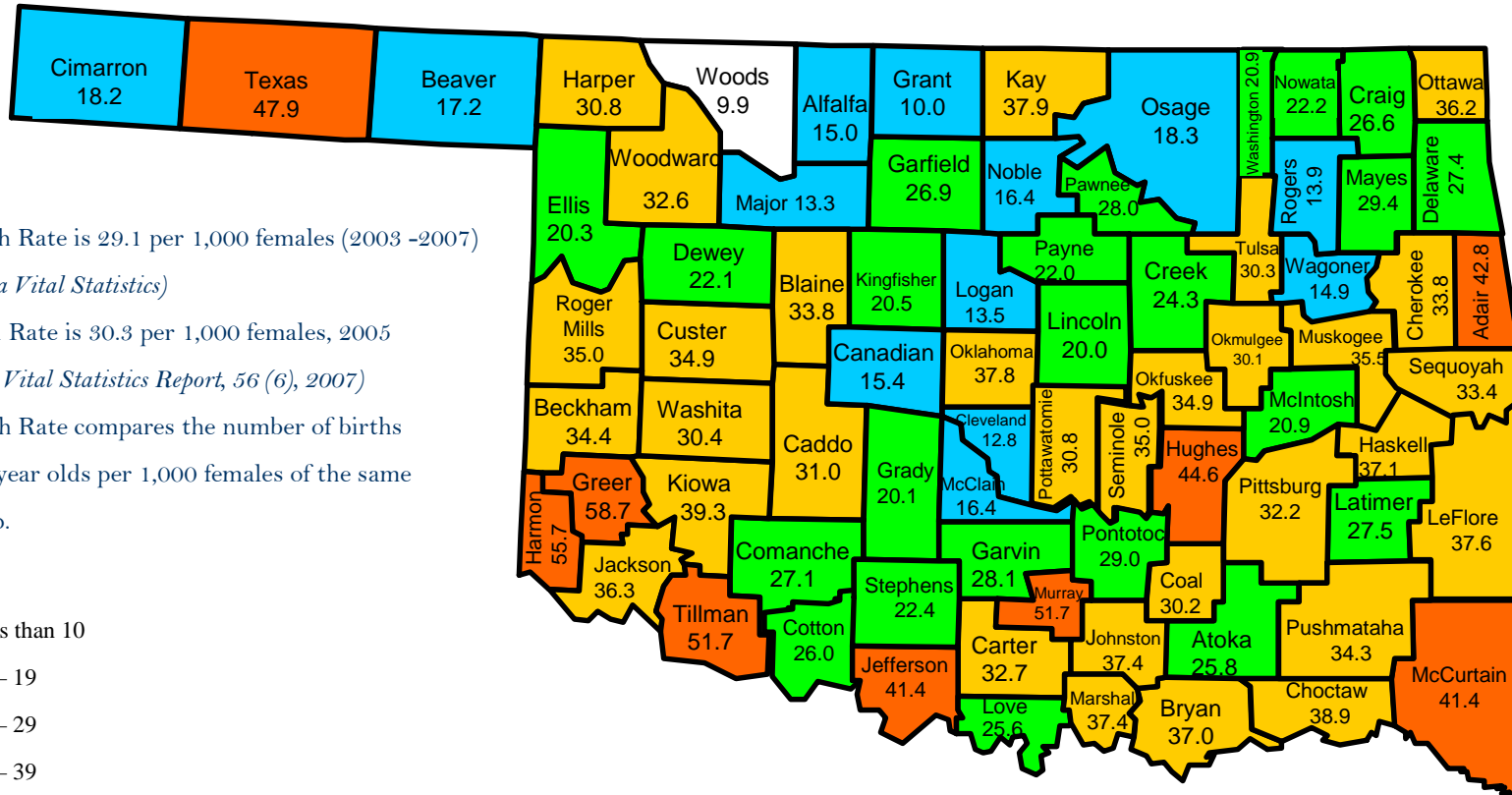
Oklahoma Ranked as 6th highest in the Nation

 #51 indicates the lowest teen birth rate

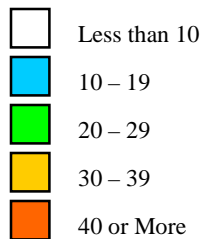

- State Birth Rate is 29.1 per 1,000 females (2003 -2007)
(Oklahoma Vital Statistics)
- U.S. Birth Rate is 30.3 per 1,000 females, 2005
(National Vital Statistics Report, 56 (6), 2007)
- Teen Birth Rate compares the number of births to 15-17 year olds per 1,000 females of the same age group.

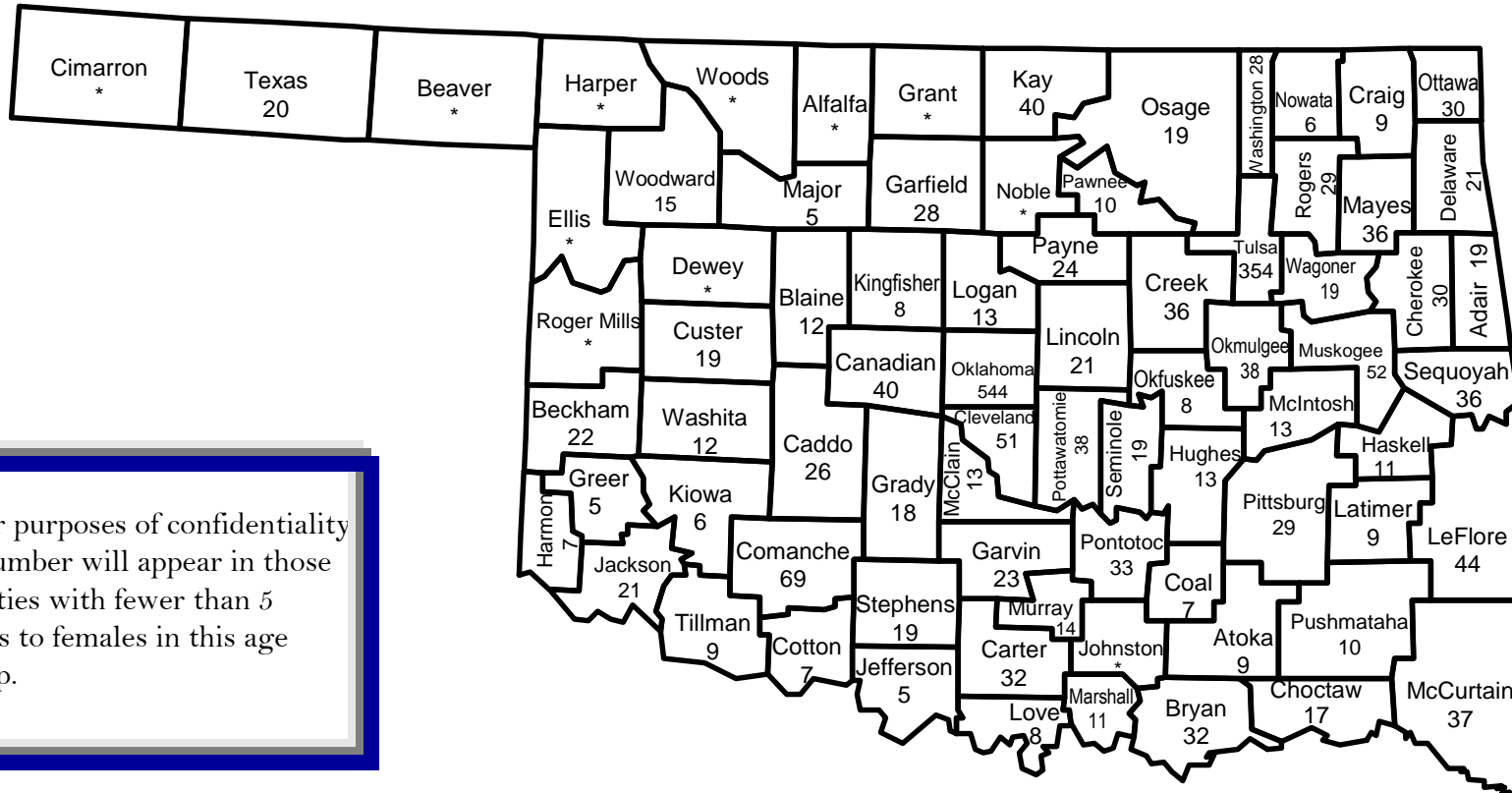


37 of Oklahoma's 77 counties have teen birth rates higher than the national average of 30.3 per 1,000 girls (ages 15-17).

Number of actual live births to females ages 15-17 in 2007.

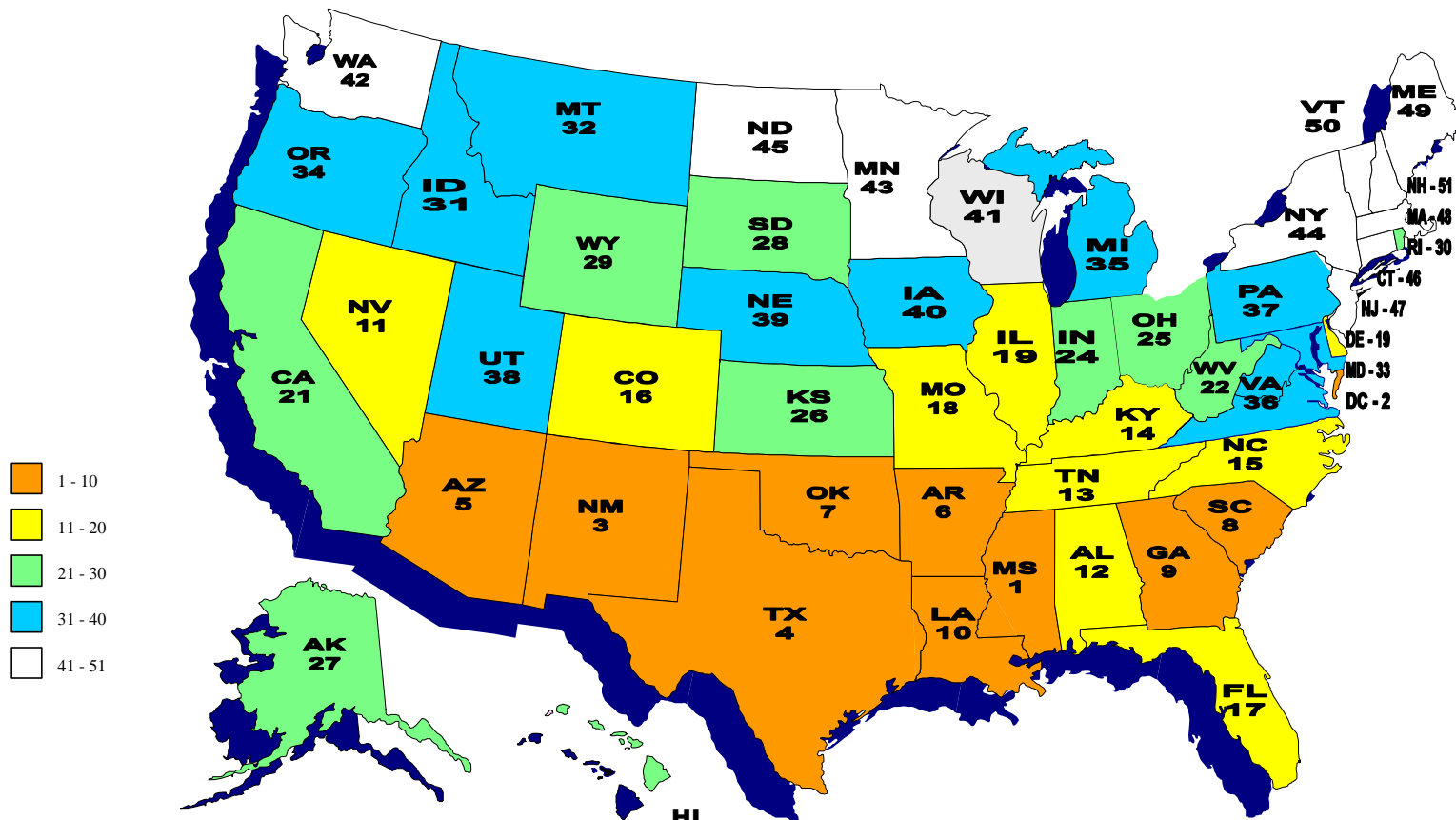
