**PURPOSE:**

The Child Abuse Training and Coordination Program (CATC Program) was statutorily created in 1990, and placed in the Office of Child Abuse Prevention, Family Support and Prevention Service, Family Health Services, Oklahoma State Department of Health.

The mandate of the CATC Program is to:

- Make available discipline specific and multidisciplinary training on child abuse and neglect and domestic violence for professionals with responsibilities affecting children, youth, and families;
- Facilitate in the development of multidisciplinary child abuse and neglect teams in counties throughout the state;
- Promote greater collaboration among individuals who serve and care for children.
