- Make available discipline specific and multidisciplinary training on child abuse and neglect and domestic violence for professionals with responsibilities affecting children, youth, and families;
- Facilitate in the development of multidisciplinary child abuse and neglect teams in counties throughout the state;
- Promote greater collaboration among individuals who serve and care for children.
