- Staffed by International Board Certified Lactation Consultants (IBCLCs)
- Provided by OU Medicine Lactation Team
- Supported by Oklahoma State Health Department Women, Infants and Children (WIC) Program and Maternal and Child Health (MCH) Service, OU Medical Center and OU Health Sciences Center OB/Gyn Department

For urgent issues, the IBCLC on call may be paged.*
