

Children are eligible to receive vaccine through the Vaccines for Children Program if they are birth through 18 years of age and meet at least one of the following :

- a) are enrolled in Medicaid
- b) do not have health insurance
- c) have health insurance that does not pay for vaccines (the underinsured)
- d) are American Indian or Alaskan Native

An administration fee of \$13.89 may be charged for each injection of VFC vaccine. A provider may not deny administration of a federally procured vaccine to a patient because the child's parent/guardian/individual of record is unable to pay the administration fee.
