She stated that she is working to close out the FFY08 grant and stated if any program managers were having any issues with purchases or spending their portion of FY08 funds, to please let her know as soon as possible.

**ITEM A:** (2009 Grant) BDW for a utility trailer for the Edmond Fire Department to be utilized for transporting shoring material and other material utilized in a technical rescue. Project Manager – Larry Hansen

**ITEM B:** (2009 Grant) BDW for the purchase of replacement batteries for handheld radios, estimated cost of \$1,550.58 Funds are from a Direct Award

awarded to Moore and Norman Fire Departments. Project Manager Larry Hansen (OCFD)/Chief Bird (Moore FD)

Joe Lester made a motion to approve the BDW and seconded by M T Berry.

**ITEM C and D:** (2009 Grant) BDW MSA 5800 Thermal Imager and Vehicle Charger for the City of Edmond and the City of Moore Fire Departments. Purchases total \$19086. Project Manager-Larry Hansen (CBRNE-UASI) Chief Bird (Moore Fire Dept)

Joe Lester made a motion to approve the BDWs and seconded by Michael Murphy.

**ITEM E:** (2008 Grant) BDW for the purchase of a Canine trained in explosive detection, at an estimated cost of \$8500. This amount is a new Direct Award being issued to Oklahoma County for this amount.

Steve Almon reported that a request has been made of the Oklahoma Office of Homeland Security by Senator Coburn's office for a copy of the UASI Investment Justification and a list of purchases made with UASI grant funds. He is not sure of the reason for the request unless it is the result of an influx of requests made to the Senator's office to review the decision made by Congress to phase out future funding for UASI projects.
