

Oklahoma Accountancy Board (OAB) Score Release

Examination scores are released by the American Institute of CPAs (AICPA) to the National Association of State Boards of Accountancy (NASBA). The OAB is not given any definitive dates when scores will be released.

The scores are released in no particular order as to the sections or dates that the sections were completed. It is possible for a candidate to receive a score notice for an examination section completed in the second month of the testing window before receiving a score notice for an examination section taken in the first month of the testing window.

Once the scores are released to the OAB they are automatically and immediately posted to the individual record; at this point the scores are considered unofficial.

The scores are then reviewed, verified and certified by the OAB staff. Once the scores are certified, official score notices are released to the candidates. Quality control standards must be met at the OAB office before any official scores are mailed.

After viewing the unofficial score on line or receiving the official score notice, a candidate may apply to retake a failed section(s) by applying online using your pin and password issued by the OAB or downloading the application and mail to the OAB with the fee.
