

## Public Service Announcement regarding work permits

Every summer, approximately 2,000 Oklahoma teens will go to work.

If you want a job, you need a work permit.

14 and 15 year olds are required to obtain a work permit, even during the summer months.

To start the process, pick up the work permit application from your school.

Complete the student section, employer section, and parental section on the application.

Return the completed application to your school's Issuing Officer.

Once the school verifies that all requirements are met, a work permit will be issued.

The employer is required to have a work permit on file before you can begin employment.
