ANALYSIS:

The Oklahoma Department of Veterans Affairs, pursuant to the legal authority granted to it in 72 O.S. § 63.3, promulgated permanent rule 770:1-3-2. This rule amendment will modernize the description of the membership of the War Veterans Commission that is contained in Title 770:1-3-2 and will also indicate how the Veteran Services organizations will submit names to Governor to fill the nine seats on the Commission. It will also reflect that all members now serve a three (3) year term on the Commission and will also state that the Commission is the funding agency for the State Accrediting Agency. It will also expand the rule to include the listing of two (2) ODVA facilities that were not in operation when the rule was first promulgated. The organizational structure that is currently in place as Appendix A to Title

770-1 is no longer applicable to the current structure of the ODVA, and that section of the rule is being revoked as a result.

PURSUANT TO THE ACTIONS DESCRIBED HEREIN, THE FOLLOWING RULES ARE CONSIDERED FINALLY ADOPTED AS SET FORTH IN 75 O.S., SECTION 308.1(A), WITH AN EFFECTIVE DATE OF JUNE 25, 2011:

SUBCHAPTER 3. ORGANIZATIONAL STRUCTURE

770:1-3-2. Program administration

(a) The War Veterans Commission is the successor to the Soldiers Relief Commission and was created by House Bill 247 of the Twenty-First Session of the Oklahoma Legislature in 1947. The Commission consists of ~~six~~nine members appointed by the Governor, with the advice and consent of the Senate, from lists of ten names submitted by The American Legion, Veterans of Foreign Wars and Disabled American Veterans. ~~Three~~Four members are selected from The American Legion, ~~two~~three members from the Veterans of Foreign Wars and ~~one~~two members from the Disabled American Veterans. ~~Effective July 1, 1976, two members will be appointed for three years, two for two years and two for one year. Thereafter, all~~All appointments will be made for a three year term.

(b) The War Veterans Commission is the controlling board for the Oklahoma Department of Veterans Affairs, Oklahoma Veterans Centers at Ardmore, Claremore, Clinton, Lawton/Ft. Sill, Norman, Sulphur and Tahihina and is responsible to the Governor for carrying out the laws enacted by the Oklahoma Legislature and for administering the veterans program in Oklahoma. The Commission has the authority to appoint the necessary personnel to administer the program. ~~They also have monetary control over~~The Commission acts as the funding agency for the State Accrediting Agency.

(c) The War Veterans Commission has authorized and charged the Director with the responsibility of administering the program.
