S. 2001, §§301-325; the latter could also include the Commission requesting

more detailed or precise disclosure or other mitigating action; in such instances, an Information could be tabled subject to the success of administrative staff in obtaining compliance, subject to the Commission's option to open an investigation should the Commission, in its discretion, find the effort lacking or insufficient
