## **ETHICS COMMISSION DIRECTOR REPLACES INFORMATION SYSTEMS NETWORK ADMINISTRATOR**

OKLAHOMA CITY. Marilyn Hughes, Executive Director of the Ethics Commission, today announced that Charles Knight has replaced Martin Miller as the Information Systems Network Administrator for the Commission.

Knight served 25 years in the United States Air Force, most recently as Superintendent of Information Management at Warren Air Force Base in Cheyenne, Wyoming. There he supervised the overall operation and maintenance of over 400 information systems within the largest missile maintenance group in the Air Force.

Knight deployed to locations in support of Operations Desert Storm, Enduring Freedom, and Iraqi Freedom. He served in various capacities throughout his career, gaining experience and knowledge with each job. He has earned an Associate Degree in Management and another Associate Degree in Administrative Management from the Air Force.

Knight's duties included overseeing the tracking and documentation of annual information protection training for over 500 system users; training newly assigned personnel on the proper operation and maintenance of computer systems; and assigning work to personnel to ensure all information systems were in compliance with DoD directives.

Knight was in charge of the deployment and installation of over 600 Voice over IP phones last year for NATO. His job included proper training and scheduling of teams sent to various locations throughout the area of responsibility in Afghanistan. He created reports that were presented to the director of communications.

Knight also coordinated training and installation of a new software program to track personnel and cargo movement throughout Afghanistan. The training included configuration and use of the software.

Upon completion of his service, Knight decided to move back to Oklahoma City. He lived here for 9 of his 25 years in the Air Force. His duties for the Commission include assisting state candidates with electronic filing, tracking both state and county campaigns and keeping the information systems for the Commission up and running.
