SUBJECT: National Emergency Grant OJT Funding

PURPOSE: To inform local WIBs (Eastern, Northeast, Central and Tulsa) of a change to the amounts in each category from the previous spreadsheet you were sent.

Memorandum M-09-2010 contained incorrect dollar amounts for the each cost category. The attached worksheet contains the correct amount of the categories. Please be advised that the total grant amount you will each receive did not change – just the amounts in each category and the number of OJT slots.

The attached NEG OJT Allocations Excel spreadsheet provides the updated following information for each of the specific grantee WIBs (Eastern, Northeast, Central and Tulsa):

- Total Grant amount;
- Administration amount;
- Program amount;
- Staff costs amount;
- OJT Contract percentage; and
- The total cost (per slot) for each OJT trainee.

Remember, these funds cannot be used to provide supportive services to trainees. Although OESC expects some supportive services for trainees will be necessary, Dislocated Worker formula funds must be used to provide those supportive services.
