TWO OF THREE RADER ESCAPEES DETAINED IN OKC

OKC--Joshua Callshim and Edward Moore, two of three recent Rader escapees, were detained by the OKC Police Department on Tuesday, March 27, at approximately 2:30 p.m.. They were picked up and taken to the Oklahoma County Detention Center. Charges are pending further investigation.

The three escaped from the Oklahoma Juvenile Affairs' (OJA) L.E. Rader Center last Thursday, March 22, 2007. An OJA investigation is continuing into the possibility of third party involvement in the escape. The two captured today could face criminal prosecution both in Tulsa and Oklahoma counties.

Sean Batt, age 18.8, from Tulsa County remains at large. Batt is a 5'6", 130 lb., Native American with blonde hair and green eyes. His offenses include Auto Burglary, Possession of a Stolen Vehicle (2 counts), Grand Larceny and Joyriding.
