OJA RELEASES GUNLOCK SAFETY PSA CAMPAIGN

OKLAHOMA CITY – Robert E. “Gene” Christian Office of Juvenile Affairs (OJA) Executive Director partners with Chief William Citty, Oklahoma City Police Department, Sheriff John Whetsel and the Oklahoma County Sheriff’s office. “Earlier this year we produced a video about a couple of cases in 2006 regarding kids and guns without adult supervision. The project is called Son Safety. The fathers of the two victims talked about the loss of their sons and the importance of storing guns safely in the home,” stated Christian. “It’s two years since these cases happened, and once again the same story has been repeated. It is our hope that this campaign for gunlocks finally stresses the importance that unsecured weapons and kids don’t mix.”
