Attempt to Locate Sexual Assault Suspect

The Oklahoma Highway Patrol is seeking information relating to a vehicle wanted in connection with a sexual assault that occurred, Sunday, May 31st, 2009, at approximately 7:00am in Oklahoma, on the Will Rogers turnpike, mile marker 256, at the rest area.



This is not an actual photograph of the suspect vehicle. This is an example of the type of tractor the suspect had.

The suspect drove a Freightliner tractor, Columbia Model, unknown year, dark blue or black in color. The truck was similar in body style to the above trucks. The truck was last seen pulling a white box trailer, and no logos were visible on either the truck or the trailer. The tractor was bearing a plain white tag with black lettering.

The suspect did not speak English and spoke in a language that was similar to Russian. The suspect was described as a male with medium complexion, with a high forehead, piercing gray eyes, 5'10" to 6', slender, muscular build, with dark brown short hair. Driver was last seen wearing a black, sleeveless t-shirt, black jogging pants with one or two white stripes down the legs, and black Air Jordan shoes. He was also wearing a gold bracelet on his right wrist, and black half-fingered driving gloves with black mesh on the back of the hands.
