OKLeX—Phase 1—PC & Camera Equipment

Other software applications may be loaded to the PC. The PC can be networked or non-networked, this is your decision. A basic PC training course is being offered to help your staff; however, attendance is not required. You may opt out of training if you feel your staff does not need training or is too busy to attend.

Phase 2—Information Sharing

Phase 2 of the OKLeX project will be to provide an Internet web site where you can search databases across the state. This will only be available to law enforcement with a secured ID and password and will require personnel from your office to attend training. Upon completion of the course, your personnel will receive their ID and password.

Rumors of requirements to perform double entry using OKLeX have been circulating. **This is absolutely false.** The OKLeX program is designed to permit every participating law enforcement agency the ability to search for persons or places of interest using the Internet. Nothing else, nada, nunca!

The Oklahoma Office of Homeland Security in collaboration with the OSBI is providing a PC package to permit all law enforcement agencies to use the same architecture for viewing data across the Internet. Please keep in mind some law enforcement agencies do not have a PC at all or do not have up-to-date PC equipment.
