<p>A Caucasian little girl, 11ish, stands in her living room. Her father is in another room, adjacent to where she is. He is holding a cigarette. The little girl talks directly into the camera. Her father is oblivious.</p>	<p>(SFX: Evocative music up and under)</p> <p>Girl: My dad thinks I'm a real math whiz. I'm pretty good... I figure if my dad smokes a pack of cigarettes a day...</p>
<p>Cross dissolve to: Daughter and dad cooking breakfast in the kitchen. Dad smoking in the background while cooking.</p>	<p>Girl: ...that's 7,300 cigarettes a year. Half of them when I'm around...</p>
<p>Cross dissolve to: Shot from the front seat of a moving car. The camera peers back at the little girl riding in the back seat. She is hiding her nose from the secondhand smoke.</p> <p>Super: Ear Infections, Bronchitis, Asthma Attacks</p>	<p>VO: Secondhand smoke causes ear infections, bronchitis and asthma attacks in children.</p>
<p>Cross dissolve to: The young girl at the dining room table doing her homework. Dad walks up to check on her. He looks at her math problem, stunned. Girl looks at Dad, Dad looks back at girl with realization.</p> <p>Fade to logo.</p> <p>Cross dissolve to white screen. TSWM logo and URL are superimposed.</p> <p>Fade to black.</p>	<p>Girl: By the time I'm 18, I'll be there for 65,700 cigarettes. Dad, does this look right to you?</p>
