- Eliminate racial and ethnic health disparities in diabetes and cardiovascular disease related mortality between whites and American Indians.
- Program objectives are accomplished through a cooperative agreement between the Oklahoma State Department of Health, five tribal partners and one urban Indian Health Care Resource Center.

Contract Period

- September 30, 2010 – September 29, 2011
- \$72,000 CEED
- CEED - Option to renew for 1 additional one-year period under the same terms and conditions (Year 4 contract modification document)
- Legacy funding varies (one year period)
- Renewal shall be based on funding availability, contactor's performance, and the needs of the OSDH



REACH US Legacy

Contract shall not take effect until OSDH has in its possession a copy containing:

- Original signatures of both parties
- Purchase Order authorizing execution of the contract



SPRUS Coalition

The SPRUS Coalition continues to develop and sustain linkages and collaboration throughout the state of Oklahoma and the Southern Plains Region which includes Kansas and Texas.

Steering Committee Meeting Schedule

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Contractor agrees to:

- Refer to “Duties of Contractor” section in current contract
- Participate in all SPRUS REACH US meetings
- Participate in all sponsored training opportunities scheduled in place of SPRUS REACH US meetings
- Submit all reports required by OSDH by the designated timeline (Report due dates posted on web site)
- Submit by July 30th, 2011 required documentation for upcoming contract period for Year 5

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Duties of the OSDH:

Agrees to serve as the Central Coordinating Organization (CCO) and will provide skilled and trained staff to perform the following activities to assist with implementation and evaluation:

- Provide technical consultation at the contractor site once per contract period
- Provide training, technical assistance, consultation and mentoring to facilitate the dissemination of best practices and evidenced-based programs to communities in the Southern Plains Region
- Provide technical assistance to contractors with evaluation plan development



Duties of the OSDH:

- Prepare and submit all CDC required reports in accordance with the designated timeline
- Assist contractors in researching potential resources for additional funding and provide consultation as requested
- Co-sponsor with OSDH procurement and fiscal management to provide contractor orientation for designated contractor orientation (within 30 days of contract initiation)



Duties of the OSDH

- Serve as a voting member in the REACH US Steering Committee in accordance to the SPURS adopted by-laws
- Review and approve contractor's monthly invoices, reports, budget revisions, out of state (OOS) travel and training requests, and contract modifications
- Maintain REACH US website and notifications list and other channels of effective communications
