Tax Rebate Information Offered

OKLAHOMA CITY — State Treasurer Scott Meacham on Tuesday offered information to help state taxpayers with questions about the tax rebate checks being delivered throughout the state this week.

“We want to help taxpayers understand why they are receiving these checks and answer any questions they might have,” Meacham said. “We want to make sure everything goes as smoothly as possible with these checks.”

Meacham said a list with answers to frequently asked questions about the tax rebate is posted on the State Treasurer’s web site at www.treasurer.ok.gov. The list includes information on where the checks can be cashed, the amount of each check and who is entitled to receive the checks.

“Most often, people are asking when the checks will be delivered,” Meacham said. “Everyone should receive their checks by next Monday, December 12th.”

Meacham said taxpayers who have not received a tax rebate check by December 12th should call the Treasurer’s Office at 405-522-3333 for help.

“If your rebate check hasn’t arrived by next Monday, we want to hear from you,” he said. “We will have staff members standing by to help.”

Meacham also announced that merchants can call the State Treasurer’s Office at 405-521-3191 to verify the issuance of rebate checks presented for payment.
