## COMPENSATION FOR AMPUTATION AND PERMANENT TOTAL LOSS OF USE OF A BODY PART SPECIFIED IN 85A O.S., §46(A)

For Injuries Occurring On And After February 1, 2014

Compensation for amputation of a body part specified in 85A O.S., §46(A) is computed at 70% of the employee's average weekly wage, not to exceed Three Hundred Twenty-three Dollars (\$323.00), multiplied by the number of weeks as set forth in the statute. Compensation for permanent total loss of use of a member shall be the same as for amputation of the member. See 85A O.S., §46(G).

The following chart is an **EXAMPLE using the maximum permanent disability rate of \$323.**
