#### Identification Requirements

All cervidae must be permanently and individually identified with 2 forms of identification. At least 1 of these must be USDA approved official identification (metal eartag, 840 RFID eartag, state eartag, or microchip).

#### Certificate of Veterinary Inspection (CVI) Requirements

All cervidae must be listed on a CVI signed by an accredited veterinarian and issued within 30 days prior to entry. The CVI must be submitted to ODAFF along with the permit application. The permit number shall be listed on the CVI after ODAFF approval.

#### Brucellosis Requirements

All cervidae 6 months of age or older must be tested negative for brucellosis within 30 days prior to entry. Cervidae from brucellosis certified free herds are exempt.

#### Tuberculosis Requirements

All cervidae 6 months of age or older must be tested negative to 2 tuberculosis tests no less than 90 days apart; the second test must be conducted within 90 days prior to entry. Cervidae from tuberculosis qualified herds must be tested negative to a single tuberculosis test within 90 days prior to entry. Cervidae from tuberculosis accredited free herds are exempt.

#### Chronic Wasting Disease Requirements

In addition to the above requirements, all whitetail deer, blacktail deer, mule deer, red deer, and elk must originate from a herd enrolled in a state or federal CWD monitoring program with at least a 5 year status. Other species are exempt.  
Import of cervidae from counties where CWD exists in native populations shall be prohibited.
