## Dairy Cattle Import Regulations

**Montana** (Brucellosis Class A & TB Free)

Steers/spayed heifers: CVI

Under 6 months of age/sexually intact: CVI + Individual ID by official eartag + No test requirements

6 -17 months of age/sexually intact: CVI + Individual ID by official eartag + Negative TB test within 60 days prior to entry **OR**  
Originate from a TB Free Herd (Herd Accreditation Number and Date of last Herd Test on CVI)

18 months and older/sexually intact: CVI + individual ID by official eartag + Negative TB test within 60 days prior to entry **OR**  
Originate from a TB Free Herd (Herd Accreditation Number and Date of last Herd Test on CVI)

**AND**

Negative Brucellosis test within 30 days prior to entry (Brucellosis vaccinated heifers test at 20 months old) **OR**  
Originate from a Brucellosis Free Herd (Herd Certification Number and Date of last Herd Test on CVI)

**New Mexico, California, Minnesota, Michigan (MI = refer to Staff Vet)** (Brucellosis Free & TB Modified Accredited Advanced)

Cattle to an APPROVED Feedlot (all ages includes steers/spayed heifers/sexually intact):

CVI approved by ODAFF + Permit required + Original CVI accompanies animals at all times + Removed from this location directly to Slaughter

Steers/Spayed heifers to Grazing:

Option 1: CVI approved by ODAFF + Permit required + Individual ID by official eartag + Original CVI accompanies animals at all times +  
Placed at a single location for grazing + Removed from this location directly to an Approved Feedlot or directly to Slaughter

Option 2: CVI approved by ODAFF + Permit required + Prem ID for origin/destination + Original CVI accompanies animals at all times +  
Group lot number + All animals remain as a group lot + Placed at a single location for grazing + Does not commingle with other cattle/bison +  
Removed from this location directly to Approved feedlot or directly to Slaughter

Cattle any purpose (all ages includes steers/spayed heifers/sexually intact): CVI approved by ODAFF + Permit required + Individual ID by official eartag  
Negative TB test within 60 days prior to entry **OR** Originate from a TB Free Herd  
(Herd Accreditation Number and Date of last Herd Test on CVI + Herd test date within 365 days)

**All other States** (Brucellosis Free & TB Free)

Steers/spayed heifers: CVI

Under 6 months of age/sexually intact: CVI + Individual ID by official eartag + No test requirements

6 months and older/sexually intact: CVI + Individual ID by official eartag + Negative TB test within 60 days prior to entry **OR**  
Originate from a TB Free Herd (Herd Accreditation Number and Date of last Herd Test on CVI)

## **Beef Cattle Import Regulations**

### **Montana**

(Brucellosis Class A & TB Free)

Steers/spayed heifers: CVI + No test requirements + Individual ID not required + Statement “These are Not Mexican Origin Cattle”

17 months and less/sexually intact: CVI + Individual ID by official eartag + No test requirements

18 months and older/sexually intact: CVI + Individual ID by official eartag +

Negative Brucellosis test within 30 days prior to entry (Brucellosis vaccinated heifers test at 24 months old) **OR**

Originate from a Brucellosis Free Herd (Herd Certification Number and Date of last Herd Test on CVI)

### **California, Minnesota, New Mexico, Michigan (MI = refer to Staff Vet)**

(Brucellosis Free & TB Modified Accredited Advanced)

Cattle to APPROVED Feedlot (all ages includes steers/spayed heifers/sexually intact):

CVI approved by ODAFF + Permit required + Original CVI accompanies animals at all times + Removed from this location directly to Slaughter

Steers/Spayed heifers to Grazing:

Option 1: CVI approved by ODAFF + Permit required + Individual ID by official eartag + Original CVI accompanies animals at all times +

Placed at a single location for grazing + Removed from this location directly to an Approved Feedlot or directly to Slaughter

Option 2: CVI approved by ODAFF + Permit required + Prem ID for origin/destination + Original CVI accompanies animals at all times +

Group lot number + All animals remain as a group lot + Placed at a single location for grazing + Does not commingle with other cattle/bison +

Removed from this location directly to Approved feedlot or directly to Slaughter

Cattle any purpose (all ages includes steers/spayed heifers/sexually intact): CVI approved by ODAFF + Permit required +

Individual ID by official eartag + Negative TB test within 60 days prior to entry **OR**

Originate from a TB Free Herd (Herd Accreditation Number and Date of last Herd Test on CVI + Herd test date within 365 days)

### **All other States**

(Brucellosis Free & TB Free)

Steers/spayed heifers: CVI + No test requirements + Individual ID not required + Statement “These are Not Mexican Origin Cattle”

17 months and less/sexually intact: CVI + No test requirements + Individual ID not required

18 months and older/sexually intact: CVI + Individual ID by official eartag + No test requirements

\* Individual ID by official eartag = USDA tag, registered tattoo, registered brand (copy of registration papers accompany animal)

## Rodeo Bull to an event

### **California, Michigan, Minnesota or New Mexico origin**

Permit required + CVI + Individual ID by official eartag + Negative Brucellosis test within 365 days prior to entry **AND**  
 Negative TB test w/i 60 days prior to entry **OR** Originate from a Tuberculosis free herd (Herd Accreditation Number and Date of last Herd Test on CVI)  
 VS 6-22 to accompany bull

### **All other states**

Permit required + CVI + Individual ID by official eartag + Negative Brucellosis test within 365 days prior to entry **AND**  
 Negative TB test within 365 days prior to entry + VS 6-22 to accompany bull

## Roping, Rodeo and Timed Event Cattle – all movement

(Mexican origin and US origin, includes bulls, steers, and heifers used for roping, excludes tie-down calves, excludes cows)

### **California, Michigan, Minnesota or New Mexico origin**

Permit required + CVI + Individual ID by official eartag + Negative TB test within 60 days prior to entry **OR**  
 Originate from a Tuberculosis free herd (Herd Accreditation Number and Date of last Herd Test on CVI) + VS 6-22 to accompany cattle

### **All other states**

Permit required + CVI + Individual ID by official eartag + Negative TB test within 365 days prior to entry + VS 6-22 to accompany cattle

## Mexican - Origin Cattle

**Grazing/Feeding only** – Imported recently from Mexico, VS 17-30 TB test only

CVI approved by ODAFF + Permit required + VS Form 17-30 faxed to ODAFF (tags must not be removed from cattle) + TB testing information on CVI  
 Statement on CVI “Mexican Origin Cattle, Shall Not Be Diverted from Grazing/Feeding/Slaughter” + Premise of destination may be Quarantined

**Used for Roping/Rodeo/Events** – Imported recently from Mexico, VS 17-30 TB test only

CVI approved by ODAFF + Permit required + VS Form 17-30 faxed to ODAFF (tags must not be removed from cattle) + TB testing information on CVI  
 Individual Identification listed on CVI (all tags must be listed) + Statement on CVI “Mexican Origin Cattle”  
 Premise of destination shall be Quarantined until negative TB test 60-120 days after VS 17-30 test date + TB test required every 12 months

## Canadian - Origin Cattle

**Beef Cattle:** CVI approved by ODAFF + Permit required + Individual ID by official eartag + Canadian origin Brand or tattoo

### **Dairy Cattle:**

**6 months and older/sexually intact:** CVI approved by ODAFF + Permit required + Individual ID by official eartag + Canadian origin Brand or tattoo  
 Negative TB test w/i 60 days prior to entry **OR** Originate from a TB Free Herd (Herd Accreditation Number and Date of last Herd Test on CVI)

**Under 6 months/sexually intact:** CVI approved by ODAFF + Permit required + Individual ID by official eartag + Canadian origin Brand or tattoo +  
 No test requirements

## Swine Import Regulations

**Sale/Show Swine** (Swine are considered Sale/Show Swine unless proof of commercial shipment)

All ages/All states:

CVI issued w/i 30 days of entry + Permit required + Individual ID by ear notch or ear tag +

Negative Brucellosis and Pseudorabies test within 30 days prior to entry **OR**

Originate from a Validated/Qualified Herd (VQ Herd Number and last quarterly test date on CVI)

### **Commercial Production Swine**

Commercial Production Companies: Cargill, Hanor, Heritage, Hitch, Maschoff, Murphy, PM Farms, Seaboard, Thunderbird, Tyson, The Pork Group, Almosta Ranch, Ron Baker, James Brandt, Elk Creek, Randy Naylor, Randy Renbarger, Top Farm, Top Hog or listed on CAFO list

**If company has Oklahoma Commuter Herd Agreement:** No permit + No CVI + No testing requirements (movement summary sent monthly)

**All Others:** CVI w/i 30 days of entry + Permit required + Individual ID not required + PRV statement + No test requirements

**SLAUGHTER:** CVI (w/i 30 days of entry) **OR** Bill of Lading/Way Bill (date, number/type of animals, owner, hauler, origin and destination)

Cattle or Swine must be from farm of origin direct to slaughter with no diversion enroute

**MARKET:** CVI (w/i 30 days of entry) **OR** Bill of Lading/Way Bill (date, number/type of animals, owner, hauler, origin and destination)

Cattle or Swine must be from farm of origin direct to market with no diversion enroute

**Equine:**

CVI w/i 30 days of entry + Negative Coggins test within 12 months (test results/ test date/ lab accession number on CVI)  
(Foals less than 6 months of age accompanied by their negative tested dam are exempt from test requirements)

**OR**

Approved current equine passport serves as CVI

**Dogs, Cats and Ferrets:** CVI w/i 30 days of entry + Rabies vaccination (vaccine used/ vaccination date on CVI)

Dogs, Cats, and Ferrets – 4 months and older must have Rabies vaccination w/i 12 months prior to entry,  
3-year vaccines will be recognized if primary vaccination and subsequent boosters are documented on CVI

**Goats:** CVI w/i 30 days of entry + Individual ID compliant with USDA Scrapie program

**Sheep:** CVI w/i 30 days of entry + Individual ID compliant with USDA Scrapie program

**Llamas:** CVI w/i 30 days of entry + Individual ID

\*Individual ID = name/age/breed/sex/color/description

**Chickens, Game Birds, Waterfowl**

Less than 4 months age: CVI (w/i 30 days of entry)

4 Months and older: CVI (w/i 30 days of entry + individual ID + test results)

Negative Pullorum test within 30 days prior to entry AND Identified by a tamperproof leg or wing band

**OR**

Participate in NPIP (National Poultry Improvement Plan) NPIP form 9-3 may be used in place of CVI.

**Turkeys:**

Less than 4 months age: CVI (w/i 30 days of entry)

4 Months and older: CVI w/i 30 days of entry + Individual ID by leg/wing band + Negative Pullorum test within 30 days prior to entry AND

Negative M. Gallisepticum test within 3 days prior to entry AND

**OR**

Participate in NPIP (National Poultry Improvement Plan) + Negative M. Gallisepticum test within 3 days prior to entry

NPIP form 9-3 may be used in place of CVI.

**Ratitae (including, but not limited to ostrich, emu, rhea):** CVI (w/i 30 days of entry + Individual ID)

**Zoo Animals:** CVI w/i 30 days of entry + individual ID

\*Individual ID = name/age/breed/sex/color/description

**Animals not listed:** CVI w/i 30 days of entry + individual ID

\*Individual ID = name/age/breed/sex/color/description
