ALFALFA HAY: Alfalfa hay movement is slow and prices are steady. Temperatures have warmed to the 70's and low 80's at midweek and dry conditions continue over the state. A cool front is to move in over the weekend, bringing colder temperatures and continued dry conditions. Wheat fields in western areas of the state need moisture as the warm temperatures encourage breaking of dormancy. Large runs of wheat pasture cattle continue at livestock auctions.

GRASS HAY: Grass hay prices are steady to weak and movement is slow. Ample supplies of grass hay are in the eastern part of the state.
