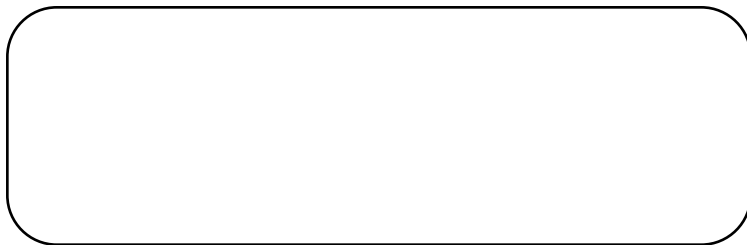

ALFALFA HAY: Alfalfa hay movement is slow and prices are steady to weak. A cold front moved across the state over the weekend bringing thunderstorms and cooler temperatures. Lows have been in the high 20's and lower 30's. The highs have been in the 40's. Snow and freezing rain is moving across the state at mid-week. Most of the state is still in need of moisture. The last big run of cattle off of wheat for grain should have happened this week.

GRASS HAY: Grass hay prices are steady to weak and movement is slow. A limited amount of grass hay is being moved as producers continue to supplement cattle.
