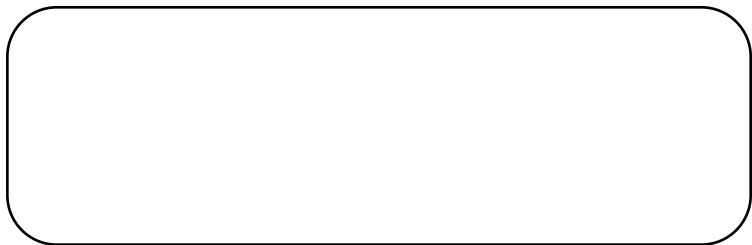

ALFALFA HAY: Alfalfa hay prices are steady and movement is slow. Heavy snow fell over the northwest third of the state last weekend and rain covered most of the rest of the state. Thunderstorms occurred in central areas the first of the week and showers are in the forecast for the weekend. The extreme southwest did not receive much moisture. The moisture in most areas should help the wheat and start grass to grow as temperatures warm.

GRASS HAY: Grass hay movement is slow and prices are steady to weak. Producers are wanting to move old crop grass hay as spring moisture and thoughts of green grass prevail. The majority of cattle on wheat for harvest are now sold or at least penned up. Auction receipts from about mid week on are mostly lower than last weeks. Supply included 92 percent over 600 lbs and 37 percent heifers.
