ALFALFA HAY: Alfalfa hay movement is slow and prices are generally steady. A hard freeze covered the entire state the first of the week. Temperatures dipped into the high teens and twenties for several hours in the major wheat growing areas of the state. It will be next week before an assessment of damage to the crop can be made. The freeze also has set back alfalfa and grass green up. Thunderstorms are in the forecast for the weekend.

GRASS HAY: Grass hay prices are steady to weak and movement is slow. Large amounts of grass hay are in inventory in the eastern half of the state and less in the western half as we go into spring.
