ALFALFA HAY: Alfalfa hay movement is slow and prices are steady. Rain showers covered much of the state over the week-end. Warm temperatures into the 80's and low 90's have warmed the state this week. Reports of the freeze damage to the wheat crop continue to come in and these reports assess that the crop in a large area of the state has been damaged. New crop hay prices have not been established. The warm temperatures are encouraging new crop alfalfa growth.

GRASS HAY: Grass hay prices steady and movement is slow. Grass is beginning to green up with the moisture and warmer temperatures.
