ALFALFA HAY: Alfalfa hay prices are steady and movement is slow. New crop prices have not been established. Thunderstorms moved across the state Monday through mid-week. Many areas received in excess of one inch or more rainfall. Alfalfa hay cutting has been slowed by the rains. The cooler temperatures and rain has been very beneficial to the state's wheat crop.

GRASS HAY: Grass hay movement is slow and prices steady. Grass growth has been slowed due to cooler temperatures, but have benefitted from the moisture.
