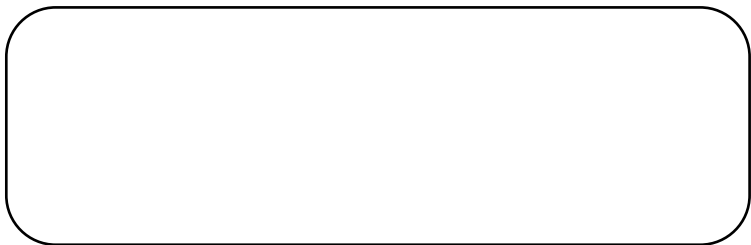

Tornados and strong thunderstorms prevailed the past week across the state, with most areas receiving rain. First cutting of alfalfa is nearing completion, with some second cutting being reported. Wheat harvest is getting into full swing in the southwest region of the state with good yields and test weights being reported.
