Limited amounts of premium dairy hay have been cut and baled, due to the weather conditions. Large amounts of fair to good quality wheat hay have been baled. Wheat harvest has been very slow to get started across the state, with harvest being ten days to two weeks later than normal.

GRASS HAY: Grass hay prices are steady to weak and movement is very slow. Grass continues to make good growth.
