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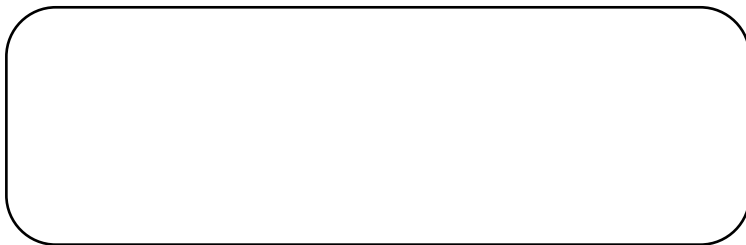

ALFALFA HAY: Alfalfa prices are steady to weak and hay movement is slow. High humidity and scattered showers have prevailed across the state this past week. These prevailing weather conditions have hampered wheat harvest and hay cutting activities. First cutting of alfalfa is virtually complete and some second cutting has occurred. Producers and consumers of hay are still trying to determine new crop prices.

GRASS HAY: Grass hay movement is very slow and prices are steady to weak. First cutting of some grass has taken place. The wet conditions this spring have made for good growth of pastures and meadows.
