ALFALFA HAY: Alfalfa hay prices are steady and movement is slow. The first day of summer, brought with it hot dry summer like conditions. High temperatures have been in the 100 degree range all week. Slightly cooler temperatures are in the forecast for the weekend. The conditions this week have allowed the wheat harvest to progress at a rapid pace, by this weekend cutting will be virtually complete in the main body of the state. Cleanup cutting and harvest in the Panhandle is all that is left to be completed. Seconded cutting of alfalfa is nearing completion.

GRASS HAY: Grass hay movement is slow and prices are steady. First cutting of grass hay is nearing 75 percent complete.
