ALFALFA HAY: Alfalfa hay movement is slow and prices are steady. A cool front brought scattered showers and 10 degree cooler temperatures across the state last weekend. Summer like temperatures and dry conditions have returned at mid-week. Wheat harvest is complete, with only cleanup cutting in the Panhandle. Second cutting of alfalfa has been completed.

GRASS HAY: Grass hay prices are steady and movement is slow. Large amounts of grass hay have been cut and baled.
