OKLAHOMA HAY REPORT  
(07/15/09)

ALFALFA HAY: Alfalfa hay movement is slow to moderate and prices steady. Extreme hot and dry conditions have prevailed over the state this past week. These conditions have taken a toll on pastures and hay fields. Third cutting of alfalfa continues. A cool front is pushing across the state at mid-week bring some relief to the 100 degree temperatures, along with some scattered showers.

GRASS HAY: Grass hay prices are steady and movement is slow to moderate. Reports of lower tonnage yields of grass hay have been coming in from most sections of the state. This is attributed to cool spring temperatures followed by extreme heat and dry conditions. Large amounts of grass hay have been cut in most other areas of the state.
