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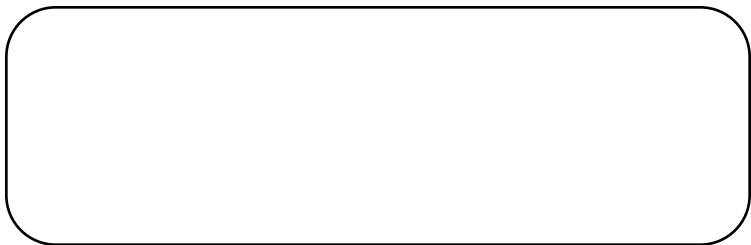

ALFALFA HAY: Alfalfa hay prices are steady and movement is slow to moderate. Temperatures have moderated this past week from the extreme hot conditions of the previous couple of weeks. Some areas of the state have received some showers, but most areas are still in need of moisture. Third cutting of alfalfa is over 50 percent complete. Moisture will be needed for the fourth cutting to produce much tonnage.

GRASS HAY: Grass hay movement is slow to moderate and prices are steady. The dry and hot conditions in most areas of the state have had a negative effect on grass hay production across the state. Compared to last week: Feeder steers and heifers steady to 2.00 higher. Demand continues good for feeder cattle despite large numbers moving off grass. Temperatures turned extremely hot last week and it was time to move cattle. Fortunately, for the producer cattle futures rose as well leading to higher country bids. Parts of North Central Oklahoma and much of Eastern Oklahoma received rains yesterday and last night. Cool front pushed thru the state giving reprieve to the high temps. Supply included 97 percent over 600 lbs; 15 percent heifers.

Unless otherwise stated prices are FOB weigh point with a 2-3 percent shrink or equivalent and with a 5-10 cent slide on calves and 3-6 cent slide on yearlings from base weights. Current sales up to 14 days for delivery.
