Scattered showers have developed in central sections at mid week. Some areas have received over an inch of rain this week. The Northwest region continues in need of moisture. In those areas that have received rain the past couple of weeks alfalfa and grass is making good growth. Fourth cutting of alfalfa has started.

GRASS HAY: Grass hay movement is slow and prices are steady. Grass meadows have made good growth in areas that have received rainfall.
