Some areas of the northwest continue to miss these showers and are in need of moisture. Fourth cutting of alfalfa continues, with producers having to dodge showers of rain.

GRASS HAY: Grass hay prices are steady and movement is slow. First cutting of grass is virtually complete, with some second cutting curing.
