Areas of the northwest that have been extremely dry received two to four inches. Some areas of north central received over eight inches. Fourth cutting of alfalfa has been slowed due to the rains this week.

GRASS HAY: Grass hay movement is slow and prices are steady. The rains this past week will allow grass in pastures and meadows to make some new growth. Compared to last week: Feeder cattle mostly steady. Demand for current delivery remains good but feed yards hesitant about contracting cattle much into the future, at least not at current prices. Futures markets have sent mixed signals this week again this week. Scattered showers and some heavy rain has again moved across some areas of the state leaving some beneficial rains. Supply included 100 percent over 600 lbs; 19 percent heifers.

Unless otherwise stated prices are FOB weigh point with a 2-3 percent shrink or equivalent and with a 5-10 cent slide on calves and 3-6 cent slide on yearlings from base weights. Current sales up to 14 days for delivery.
