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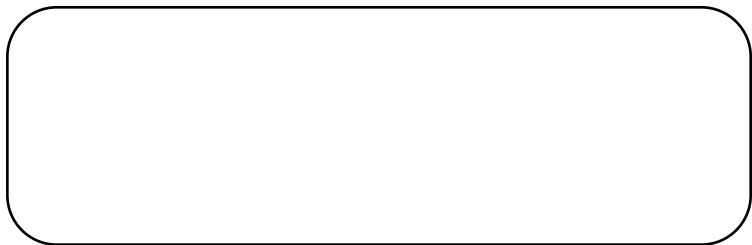

ALFALFA HAY: Alfalfa hay movement is slow and prices are steady. Hot temperatures returned to the state over the past weekend. Showers returned to the central part of the state at mid-week bringing cooler temperatures. The rainfall that has been received the past couple of weeks has producers thinking about planting wheat for pasture after the first of the month. Fourth cutting of alfalfa continues with producers dodging rain showers.

GRASS HAY: Grass hay prices are steady and movement is slow. Second cutting of grass hay is occurring in some areas of the state. Grass continues to make good growth because of the August showers.
